 The Gujarat Chief Minister, Mr. Amarsinh Chaudhary's supporters gave a massive demonstration of his following in Surat district with a rally at the taluka town of Bardoli on Friday afternoon. The rally which was organised by his close associate, Mr. Sahadev Chaudhary, who has been expelled from the Congress(I) for the post one and half years; attracted a crowd of about two lakh people.
 It was marked by a warning to the members of the State Legislative Assembly opposed to the Chief Minister that they would start picketing their houses from April 24, if they failed to reconsider their stand and support the only Advasi Chief Minister in the country.
 Despite a reported threat by the Chief Minister, Mr. Chaudhary and the Gujarat Pradesh Congress(I) chief, Mr. Prabhoo Raval, that disciplinary action would be initiated against those attending the rally called by the expelled panchayat chief, nearly 20 municipal corporators owing allegiance to the Chief Minister and the former Transport Minister, Mr. Mohammed Surti's faction in the Surat Municipal Corporation, 22 district panchayat members belonging to the faction and even two Janata Party panchayat members in Surat district panchayat, along with scores of taluka panchayat members attended the rally.
 It may be noted here that the rally was organised at the same place (Surti Jakt Naka) in this historic town, where the veteran national leader, Sardar Patel, had launched the freedom struggle against the British. Even the Prime Minister, Mr. Rajiv Gandhi, had addressed a public meeting at the same place during the 1984 parliamentary elections.

Pak violence toll goes up to 14
 KARACHI, April 7 (PTI)
 The death toll in Thursday's ethnic riots in Hyderabad city, about 160 kms from here, climbed to 14 after four people succumbed to injuries, doctors said.
 Riots broke out in Hyderabad on Thursday between the native Sindhis and the Urdu-speaking Muhajirs. Gunbattles between the two groups at a dozen places left 10 dead and more than 60 wounded.
 Four of the injured died later, and doctors said another six were on the critical list.
 Troops were called out and an indefinite curfew was clamped on the city. Officials in Hyderabad said curfew would not be relaxed on Friday.
 In Karachi Pakistan's Prime Minister, Mrs. Benazir Bhutto, reacted sharply on Thursday night over the Hyderabad riots, and said the "saboteurs would never be allowed to take the entire society as hostage".
 Speaking at a banquet, Mrs. Bhutto diverged from the written text to condemn the killing.

Unrest in Haiti continues
 PORT-AU-PRINCE, April 7 (DPA)
 Haitian palace soldiers trained rockets and machinegun fire on three road stations that had defied Government censorship amid signs on Friday that they revolt against General Prosper Avril's Government has not ended.
 Troops destroyed Radio Liberte, Radio Metropole and Radio Antilles early on Thursday evening. Earlier, mutinous soldiers and civilian protesters set up burning barricades across the main roads of the Haitian capital.
 In retaliation for the public display of opposition to the Government, which survived a coup attempt last Sunday, pro-Avril troops moved on Radio Liberte which had defied state censorship.
